Ms. De Schutter will work with local lighting enthusiasts and conference attendees from the Winter Cities Shake-Up Conference to design and unveil a lighting installation. The lighting feature will be unveiled at the WinterShines opening and remain viewable throughout the entire festival.

“Our goal is to become a city that is world-renowned for celebrating its winter climate,” says Shad Ali, WinterShines President. “The Nutrien WinterShines 2019 Festival is a perfect way for citizens and visitors to build community, while fully embracing winter and all it brings with it.”
